The personal information we collect about you, and how we use or disclose that information, depends largely on the services that you have sought to be performed. This Privacy Policy tells you how your personal information is collected, used, distributed and protected by us.

Collection

We collect information about you to provide services you have sought, and to keep you informed of other services offered by us which may be of interest. Types of information we collect and handle includes:

- Identity and contact details of you;
- Your financial circumstances and credit history details;
- Your employment and occupation details;
 - Your date of birth, marital status and number of dependents;
- Your asset and liability details;
- Any service requirements you may have.

If you do not provide us with this information, we may not be able to provide you with the services you are seeking.

In some circumstances, in order to provide the services you have sought, we may need to obtain information about you from others. We will collect only that information which is necessary for the purposes of your dealings with us. We do not collect 'sensitive' information such as:

- Racial or ethnic origins;
- Philosophical beliefs;
- Political opinions or memberships;
- Sexual preferences;
- Professional or trade union memberships;
- Criminal records;

Religious beliefs;

Health information

We will not adopt Commonwealth Government identifiers as our own, and if we do collect these we will use them only for identification purposes.

The information we collect about you depends on how you use our web site. We only collect your personal information from our web site if you send us an email using one of the links or forms from the site.

The information collected is limited to the detail you enter within the form, your email address and the contents of any message you may send to us. Personal information collected from our web site will only be used for the purpose for which you have provided it and it will not be added to a mailing list or used for any other purpose without your consent.

Use & Disclosure

Our use and disclosure of personal information about you is dictated by the service you take up. We will not use or disclose your information for a purpose unrelated to the services we provide to you or for any other purpose outside your reasonable expectations unless:

- We are required or authorised to do so by law;
- You have consented to us disclosing the information which we have told you about.

Generally, we use or disclose your personal information for such purposes as:

- Servicing our relationship with you;
- Regulatory reporting and compliance;
- Internal accounting and administration;
- Assisting us to identify and inform you about other services which we offer that may be of interest to you.

To provide our services to you in the most cost effective and efficient way, we may need to utilise the services of third parties. In addition, you may have been introduced to us by a third party in which case that third party introducer will also have access to your information.

Any third party that we use to assist us in providing services to you will be restricted from using your personal information other than for the specific purpose for which we supply it.

As we take our obligation to protect your personal information very seriously we make every effort to deal with third parties who share and demonstrate this same attitude.

Quality, Access & Correction

Personal Information which we hold about you is integral to decisions we make about the services which we provide to you. It is essential that this information is correct. We make every effort to ensure that your personal information is accurate and up-to-date whenever we collect or use it.

To assist us with this, you should let us know if you find that current personal information we hold about you is inaccurate, incomplete or out-of-date. We will use all reasonable efforts to correct the information.

You are also welcome to access the information we hold about you and to draw any inaccuracies to our attention.

We should point out that you will not be able to access all information we hold about you. There are a number of exemptions including but not limited to:

- where the access impacts on the privacy of others; •
- where there are existing or anticipated legal proceedings and the information is 'privileged';
- in the case of frivolous or vexatious requests;
- in some instances the access can be denied under law or by a law enforcement agency.
- where the information is deemed to be evaluative;

A fee may apply to cover our reasonable costs associated with your request. If we deny your request for access, we will let you know why.

Transborder Data Flows

Where necessary, your personal information may be transferred outside Australia. We will ensure that any organisation involved will appropriately safeguard the privacy of the information provided to them.

We will safeguard personal information we handle about you. This includes taking all reasonable measures to protect your personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification and disclosure, both internally and externally.

We may store your personal information in hardcopy documents or electronically on our computer systems.

Changes to Our Privacy Policy

From time to time we may make changes to our Privacy Policy.
